NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules

1.1 The races will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Yachting New Zealand Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016.

1.2 The YNZ Safety Regulations Part V Category C shall apply.

1.3 An Amendment to Section 13.3 shall apply where all boats must carry a minimum of 10 Litres of fuel at the start of racing

2. Eligibility and Entry

2.1 Open to all trailer and keel yachts 5.2 meters (17 ft.) and over.

2.2 Advance entries will be accepted until the normal closing date of Friday 5th February 2013 by completing the entry form accompanied by a fee of \$50 (fee entitles entrant to compete in both races) and mailing it to The Secretary, Wakatipu Yacht Club, P O Box 182, Queenstown . Event information and entry forms will also be available from www.wakatipuyachtclub.co.nz or 021 347 306

2.3 Late entries, accompanied by an additional late entry fee of \$10.00 may be accepted at the Race Committee's discretion during registration on race day.

3. Schedule of Events

3.1 Registration

Club to Club

Registration:

0800hrs Saturday 6th Feb at The Wakatipu Yacht Club, Kelvin Peninsula, Queenstown.

The club to club race will be one single division of all entered boats.

All results will be based on national handicaps

The race will start no earlier than 0930hrs Saturday 6th February.

The Start will be between the Wakatipu Yacht Club caravan and a buoy located across the narrows

The finish line will be between the end of the Kingston wharf and the adjacent 5 knot marker.

Registration:

0800hrs to 0830hrs Sunday 7th Feb at Kingston golf club house 32 Gloucester St Kingston

Format:

There will be three divisions based on national handicap ratings.

The Start will be between the end of the committee boat and a large yellow buoy.

A gate will be set up at the half way stage with a buoy rounding off half way bay on the same side of the lake as the road to take times at this stage of the race.

The finish line will be between entrance to the narrows and a buoy across the narrows.

One eligible trailer yacht in each division will need to be across the finish line at Wakatipu yacht club by 1600hrs for full results to be taken at the finish line.

If less than 3 eligible boats in each division do not cross the finish line at Wakatipu yacht club then the half way mark times will be used to determine the remaining place getters in that division.

If one eligible boat from each division does not cross the finish line at The Wakatipu Yacht Club by 1600hrs the times will be used from the half-way point to determine results.

All boats must be finished within 1 hour after the first boat in that division crosses the finish line
